Adjustable Floor Task Lamp Assembly Instructions

Important Safety Instructions:

- For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.
- These instructions are provided for your safety. It is important that they are read carefully and completely before assembling fixture.
- This fixture has been rated for up to (1) 60-watt maximum TYPE T tube bulb (not included) OR 13-watt compact fluorescent bulb (included in box). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

Warning:

- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on. Do not look directly at lit bulb.
- Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.



Hardware included:

- (1) Spring washer (a)
- (1) ½" Hex nut (b)

To Assemble You Will Need:

• (1) Wrench (G) (Enclosed)



Pre-assembly:

- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

To Assemble:

- 1. Carefully open the box removing all packing material.
- 2. Join parts (D), (E) & (F) together by tightening washer (a) and nut (b).
- 3. Tighten with Allen wrench (G) provided.
- 4. Attach the handle of shade (A) to socket tube (B).
- Insert bulb (either standard incandescent or Compact Fluorescent Bulb (J) into threaded socket.
- 6. Remove protective plug cover from plug.
- 7. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test fixture.
- 8. Assembly is complete.

To Adjust Base Height:

- Loosen adjustment break (H) found on lamp stem.
- Adjust lamp by pulling or pushing upper lamp pole (C) up or down to desired height.
- Tighten adjustment break (H).

Care Instructions:

- Wipe with soft dry cloth only
- · Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasives as they may damage the finish
