

## Desmond Floor Lamp

Assembly Instructions

Important Safety Instructions:

- This portable luminaire has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.
- These instructions are provided for your safety. It is important that they are read carefully and completely before assembling fixture.
- This fixture has been rated for up to (1) 100-WATT MAXIMUM TYPE A STANDARD BULB (not included) OR (1) 23W Compact Fluorescent bulb (H) (included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

## Warning:

- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on. Do not look directly at lit bulb.
- Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

Parts Enclosed:

- (1) Finial (A)
- (1) Harp (B)
- (1) Harp saddle (C)
- (1) Lamp pole (D)
- (1) Lamp base (E)
- (1) Base weight (F)
- (1) Felt paper (G)
- (1) CFL light bulb (H)

## Pre-assembly:


- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

## To Assemble:

- 1. Remove all parts carefully from box.
- 2. Join lamp pole (D), lamp base (E) and base weight (F) together, and slide washer (a) over the threaded pipe which protrudes from bottom of base weight (F).
- 3. Screw nut (b) onto the threaded pipe to secure lamp base to lamp pole, and tighten with wrench (c) provided.
- 4. Remove the backing sheet from felt paper (G), affix the felt paper (G) underneath the base weight (F).
- 5. Insert harp (B) into harp saddle (C).
- 6. Unscrew the finial (A) from the harp (B) and place the desired shade (not included) over the harp.
- 7. Attach the finial (A) and tighten to secure the shade.
- 8. Insert bulb into the socket.
- 9. Plug lamp into proper electrical outlet and test fixture.

Care Instructions:


- Wipe with soft dry cloth only
- Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasives as they may damage the finish
