



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

The bed is composed of several components: The headboard, foot board, side rails, support slats, wooden panel, post, , canopy rail. Determine the intended location and ensure there is enough space to work with and fully read these instructions before physically doing the entire assembly.

STEP #1:

Attach the minifix bolts (6) into the fixed nuts on the headboard (A) as per illustrated in FIGURE 1.

STEP #2

Remove the mini fix lock from the mini fix nut (7), as per illustrated in FIGURE 2-A. Insert the minifix nuts into the holes on back of headboard panel (A) and top of the canopies (H), then use a screwdriver to adjust the minifix nut to make sure the hole on it is aligned with the bore hole on the end of the canopy, as per illustrated in FIGURE 2-B.

STEP #3:

Align the minifix bolt (6) on the headboard posts (D) into the minifix nut (7) through the bore hole on the end of the headboard panel (A) and the canopy (D). Re-insert the minifix lock to secure the minifix bolt to the minifix nut, and the headboard panel and canopy will be fixed to the headboard post. See FIGURE 2-C

STEP #4:

Repeat all the above procedure with the other Footboard panel (B) and canopy rail (H) to attach it to the footboard post (E).







STEP #5:

Place the headboard assembled upright in the position you wish the bed to be in when fully assembled. The headboard bed fast hardware should be facing inside, toward the mattress. Secure the threaded rod (1) to the fixed nut in the headboard by simply turning it manually. Raise the side rail (C) and place the rod (1) to align with the bore holes on the end of the side rails (C). Put the side rails (C) up against the headboard so the threaded rods (1) go through the bore holes. Insert curved washer (2), lock washer (3) and place hex nuts (4) on threaded rod (1) then tighten the hex nuts (4) with wrench (5) provided, see **FIGURE 3**.

STEP #6:

Attach the minifix bolts (6) into the fixed nuts on the headboard as per illustrated in **FIGURE 4**.

STEP #7:

Remove the mini fix lock from the mini fix nut (7), as per illustrated in **FIGURE 5-A**. Insert the minifix nuts into the holes on top of the canopies (I), then use a screwdriver to adjust the minifix nut to make sure the hole on it is aligned with the bore hole on the end of the canopy, as per illustrated in **FIGURE 5-B**.

STEP #8

Align the minifix bolt (6) on the headboard into the minifix nut (7) through the bore hole on the end of the canopy (I). Re-insert the minifix lock to secure the minifix bolt to the minifix nut, and the canopy will be fixed to the headboard. See **FIGURE 5-C.** KEEP HOLDING THE CANOPY DURING NEXT STEP.

STEP #9

Repeat the above procedure with the other side rail (C) and canopy rail (I) to attach it to the headboard, and then repeat to connect to the footboard assembled.
